SPECIMEN TRACKING SERVICE AVAILABLE

KDL Pathology | Knoxville Dermatopathology Laboratory strives to provide the highest quality in both patient diagnostics and client services. To ensure we meet those goals, the laboratory maintains an active quality assurance program. Specimen labeling, documentation, and tracking are critical components of accurate laboratory diagnostics and reporting.

KDL offers a specimen tracking receipt system to its clients to ensure that all specimens are actually received by the laboratory. At the end of each day, KDL will automatically email you an activity list of all specimens received, accessioned and processed by the laboratory.

KDL maintains a number of specimen tracking safety procedures within the laboratory, including:

- Bar Coding system for medical practice and case identification
- Specimen tracking begins with personalized requisitions containing a 2D barcode for both practice and specimen ID
- Case number tracking from requisition to patient specimen to block to slide to diagnostic report
- Cross checking of finished reports daily against received specimens to ensure that all completed cases are reported

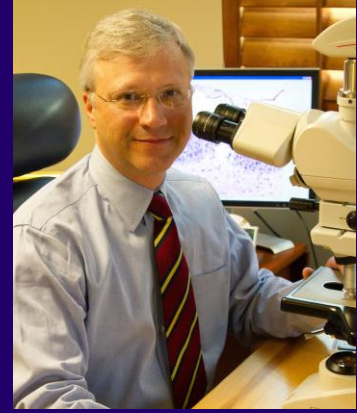
